The length was thirty-three inches. At this age the proportions of the body, and of the organs, are no longer those of the infant, and not yet those of the adult. The anatomy of this age has received little attention, and I hope that this work may therefore be of use. It will serve, also, for the study of the adult relations, as the peculiarities due to the age of the subject are carefully noticed in the text. I have endeavored to call attention to the most important inferences to be drawn from the plates, and have mentioned, incidentally, many points of...
